CITY OF MARINETTE CAMPGROUND RULES

- 1. Register for a vacant site at marinette.recdesk.com, at 2501 Pierce Ave, or by calling 715.732.2006.
- 2. All campers must pay for the entire length of stay when registering.
- 3. Campsites are available to rent for fourteen (14) consecutive nights and then campsites must be vacated for seven (7) nights.
- 4. Children under 12 must be supervised by an adult (age 18 or older) at all times.
- 5. Follow all City of Marinette Municipal Code:

12-1-1(b)(8) Making of Fires: No person shall start, tend, or maintain a fire except in personal grills or designated fireplaces. Personal grills shall be used only in designated picnic areas. The use of personal grills is permitted provided lawns and vegetation are not endangered. Unburned fuel and ashes shall be disposed of in such manner as to prevent fire or damage to any park property.

12-1-1(b)(13) Glass Beverage Bottles in Parks Prohibited: No person shall possess any glass beverage bottle within the limits of the parks of the City.

12-1-1(b)(15) Parking in Parks: No person shall park any motor vehicle in any park in the City except in a designated parking area.

12-1-4(a)(1) Campground Availability: The campground in City Park shall be open twenty-four (24) hours per day during the months of May through September and closed during the months of October through April.

12-1-9(8) Maximum Number of Motor Vehicles and Related Fee: In addition to the camping unit, the occupant of any campsite may keep a maximum of two (2) motor vehicles and/or trailered boats thereon without incurring an additional fee. There shall be a fee of

\$5.00 per day for each additional motor vehicle and/or trailered boat

kept on site. All vehicle trailers where applicable sha<mark>ll be licensed.</mark>

12-1-10(b) Regulation of Animals at Parks; No person shall allow any dog

to run at large on the grounds of any such city park.

Any owner or person in charge of a dog on the grounds of any such city park shall control such dogs by means of an attached leash, shock collar, or similar electronic control device.

This subsection shall not apply to dogs confined within the interior of a

motor vehicle.
